

Registering for Graduate Level Classes (500 and 600 level)

Graduate students in a degree program at UMaine

- Students may register themselves on MaineStreet, through their department, or with the Graduate School **if** they have a signed registration form from their advisor or email approval from the advisor.
- **Please note: First time graduate students must complete their first registration with the graduate school.**

Graduate students in a degree program at another university

- Students must complete a non-degree application or a visiting student application and submit it to the Graduate School.
- The visiting student application is primarily used by international students, and does require a signature from the Dean of the Graduate School at their home university.

Anyone wishing to take a graduate level class who has at least a baccalaureate degree and is not enrolled as a current student

- Prospective students must complete a non-degree application and registration form and submit them to the Graduate School.

Undergraduate students at Orono

- Undergraduate students at Orono, usually with senior status, can take graduate level classes with written permission of the instructor and their advisor.
- They need to be registered by their respective dean's office or CED at the undergraduate level.

Undergraduate students from another university or college

- Undergraduate students from another college or university may take graduate level classes with written permission from the instructor (email is fine) and written permission from the Associate Dean of the Graduate School, Scott Delcourt.
- These permissions will be forwarded to the Office of Continuing Education (CED) who will register the student as a non-degree undergraduate.
- The student will be taking the class at the undergraduate level.

****Any non-degree graduate student who takes an undergraduate class along with a graduate level class must take the undergraduate class at the graduate level and pay the graduate level tuition rate. **Students cannot be registered on both levels******
